

How to Get Your Massage Therapy License in Texas

Licensing is obtained by applying with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulations (TDLR). The applicant must first meet the following criteria:

- 1. Complete a State-approved 500-hour Massage Therapy training program.
- 2. Take and pass the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Exam (MBLEx).
- 3. Take and pass a Jurisprudence Exam on Texas massage laws and rules.
- 4. Complete the application & application fee for a Massage Therapy License and submit 500 Hour transcripts, MBLEX results, and fingerprints to TDLR.





What does the MBLEx look like?

Texas requires potential therapists to pass the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Examination 'MBLEx' test. This is a 100-question multiplechoice test given on a computer and timed at 2 hours. It is administered through an online testing center approved by the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB).

After becoming a Licensed Massage Therapist you are required to maintain your licensure by completing 12 hours of Continuing Education every 2 years.



How does TLC's Curriculum Differ from other schools?

We also teach the Lauterstein Method which is also known as Deep Massage. Deep Massage is about high quality of connection, not about quantity of pressure. The techniques evolved as combinations of soft tissue and skeletal work. Deep Massage cultivates a theory and practice which aims to contact the person in such a way that they let go from the inside out. If they don't let go from within, then nothing really significant can happen!

The TLC Student Massage Clinic provides extensive practice in Integrative Massage Therapy Techniques while working on a wide variety of clients that are provided by the school. During their time in the Internship, they will practice the therapeutic, communication, and business skills taught in class while working in a professional setting. This helps students build their confidence by gaining real-world experience.

The State requires all students to complete 50 hours of massage therapy sessions in a supervised setting. Our Internship is 50 1-hour sessions in the Student Clinic, scheduled outside the student's regular class time. Students are eligible to start the Internship halfway through the program.

2022 Class Schedules

Need a morning, afternoon, evening, or weekend schedule? The Lauterstein-Conway Massage School offers a variety of schedules to meet the needs of every student. We provide both full-time (6 months) and part-time classes (12 months). The full-time classes meet in the mornings or afternoons 4 days a week. The part-time classes meet in the evenings 2 days a week or on Saturdays once a week.

Paying for School

We know that paying for school can be one of the biggest obstacles students face when starting a new educational program. At The Lauterstein-Conway Massage School, we want to give our students every opportunity to succeed by offering no-credit-check payment plans so all students qualify to make paying for school easy.

Tuition is \$6,790 and there is an additional non-refundable application fee of \$100 that can be paid online once you have completed the online application. Additional costs for books and supplies vary according to purchase prices. See Books & Supplies list for estimated cost of additional materials.

1. Pay in Full - Receive \$400 TLC Gift Card for books & supplies.

\$200 deposit required at enrollment. \$6,590 due 10 days before start date. Gift cards redeemable online or in person for books, supplies, massage table, internship massage appointments or continuing education. TLC Gift Cards are NOT redeemable for cash, tuition or non-tuition fees. Gift cards are issued once full payment is received.

2. Pay Half & Half - Receive \$200 TLC Gift Card for books & supplies.

\$200 deposit required at enrollment. \$3295 due 10 days before start date and \$3295 due halfway through program (by class 56). Gift cards redeemable online or in person for books, supplies, massage table, internship massage appointments or continuing education. TLC Gift Cards are NOT redeemable for cash, tuition or non-tuition fees. Gift cards are issued once first half payment is received.

3. TFC Financing Plan

All students qualify. No credit check required. Payments can be made on the 14th or 29th of every month. See Tuition Financing chart below for monthly payments, financing term lengths and interest rates options.
