

37b Business: State Massage Law and Find a Job

Lesson Plan

<u>Minutes</u>	<u>Activity</u>
10	Break Announce the return time and write it on the board
5	Attendance Also project the “Reminders” for upcoming classes
15	Lecture: History of Texas massage therapy law
40	Student Activity – students count off by 1, 2, 3. Assign a scorekeeper by the whiteboard. Give 1 or 2 questions per each successive group of 1, 2, 3’s. Students must keep hands in their lap until you have read the question and said “Go!”. First to light their light, gets to be first to answer question. Go to through entire powerpoint and declare a winning group at the end. Usually it takes about an hour and a half.
