150 questions worth .66 points each. Classmarker only allows one digit after the decimal so your instructor will calculate your grade.

The total number of possible correct answers (A) = 150

Minus the of incorrect answers = \_\_\_\_\_(B)

Total number of correct answers = \_\_\_\_\_(C)

C divided by 150 = (D) Move decimal 2 spaces to the right.

Round up to the next whole number if the decimal is .5 or greater, round down to the next whole number if the decimal is less than .5

$$A - B = C$$

$$C / 150 = D$$
